## Works Information Notice

Scheme: Drainage Improvement – Vale Avenue, Worthing  
Start Date: Week Commencing 2<sup>nd</sup> August 2010  
Duration of Works: 1 week, weather permitting

### Summary of Scheme

The objective of the scheme is to upgrade the existing drainage system by installing a new, larger diameter pipe to alleviate flooding outside the entrance to the Vale First and Middle School. The new pipe will be laid in the carriageway and will connect the existing gully opposite number 84 Vale Avenue to an existing manhole outside number 24 Vale Drive.

### Duration

The Scheme is currently scheduled to run for up to 1week, however this depends on the weather conditions.

### Hours of work

Work will generally take place from 7am to 5pm, Monday to Friday only.

### Traffic Management

During the course of the works, a combination of 2 way traffic lights and “Give and Take” traffic management will be used. The 2 way lights may remain in place until the materials have hardened. Generally, these will be erected each morning and taken down at the end of the day to allow rush hour traffic to pass through freely.

### Parking

During the course of the works, it may be necessary to utilise some of the on-street areas which may reduce the availability of parking. This is necessary in order to permit traffic to pass the contractors plant during the works. We understand this may cause inconvenience and disruption to you, however, any suspensions will be kept to a minimum in terms of duration and length of parking places affected.
