### **NEWPOUND LANE – WISBOROUGH GREEN DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS REQUIRING A TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE**

Works to improve the highway drainage on Newpound Lane near Field House is due to start shortly, from **Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> August** and is expected to take around 3 days to complete. The work involves excavation and installation of a new gully and outlet pipe.

Due to the narrow road width and location of underground services, it will be necessary to close Newpound Lane to through traffic for the period of the works. The temporary closure will be near Field House on Newpound Lane. The alternative route for vehicles will be via Durbans Road, A272, Newpound (to Newpound Common), Newpound Lane. Please see the plan overleaf.

The work will be undertaken by West Sussex Highways on behalf of West Sussex County Council. I will supervise the works on site, so should you need to contact me during the course of the works please call 01243 642105. Residents who live along Newpound Lane will have vehicular and pedestrian access to their properties from the Southern end up to the closure and from the Northern end down to the closure.

If you feel the work is likely to cause a problem for members of your household which could be helped by special arrangements; eg. for wheelchair users, less mobile or visually impaired people, or for special deliveries you might be expecting, please contact me.

#### *Warning*

From time to time you may be approached by groups of men in smart vehicles offering to carry out works to the property such as resurfacing garage drives and footpaths. The work offered is generally to be carried out at the weekend for payment in cash only. We advise you to take extreme caution if you consider such an offer as these men are not associated in any way with West Sussex County Council, May Gurney Limited or Amey plc.
