Scheme:	Pedestrian Enhancement Scheme East Street, Horsham
Start Date:	6th April 2010
Duration of Works:	Up to 22 weeks, weather permitting.

Summary of Scheme

The scheme objective is to create an attractive, pedestrian friendly, safe and accessible public space by constructing a level surface using quality paving materials. The scheme will improve facilities for non-motorised users whilst maintaining vehicular access for loading and unloading activities and blue badge holders.

Duration

The scheme is currently scheduled to run for 22 weeks. Work is planned to start from 6th April 2010.

Hours of work

Work will generally take place from 7.30 am to 6pm. On occasions work may continue on Saturdays.

Road closure & diversion route

To allow the works to be undertaken in the safest possible manner for the workforce, pedestrians and motorists, the road will need to be closed periodically during the works, during which time access for deliveries only will be permitted via Carfax.

The diversion route is Park Way, Albion Way, Bishopric Link, Worthing Road, Black Horse Way and Carfax.

Parking

During the course of the works, it may be necessary to utilise some of the on-street areas which may reduce the availability of parking. This is necessary in order to permit traffic to pass the contractors plant during the works. We understand this may cause inconvenience and disruption to you, however, any suspensions will be kept to a minimum in terms of duration and length of parking places affected.
