## Works Information Notice

Scheme: Sign installation between Whiteways Lodge Roundabout and Storrington along the B2139

Start Date: Week commencing 19<sup>th</sup> July 2010

Duration of Works: Up to 3 weeks, weather permitting.

### Summary of Scheme

The scheme objective is to improve the advanced signing for the restricted headroom at the railway bridge near Amberley Railway Station. The works will involve installing new signs and posts at various locations.

### Duration

The scheme is currently scheduled to run for up to 3 weeks. Work is planned to start from week commencing 19<sup>th</sup> July 2010.

### Hours of work

Work will generally take place from 7am to 5pm, Monday to Friday only.

### Traffic management

During the course of the works, 2 way and 3 way traffic lights will be erected on site at various stages of the works. They may remain in place until the materials have hardened. Generally, these will be erected each morning and taken down at the end of the day to allow rush hour traffic to pass through freely.

### Parking

It may be necessary to utilise some of the nearby on-street areas which may reduce the availability of parking. We understand this may cause inconvenience and disruption to you, however, any suspensions will be kept to a minimum in terms of duration and length of parking places affected.

### Overhanging vegetation

I would be obliged if, prior to the commencement of these works, any vegetation from your property overhanging the highway could be trimmed back to your boundary. Failure to do this may necessitate the contractor undertaking this trimming back, which may not necessarily produce the same standard that you would wish or could achieve yourself.
