Works Information Notice

Scheme Traffic Calming Measures – Fishbourne Road (East), Chichester

Start Date: Week commencing Monday 26th July 2010

Duration of works Up to 5 weeks

Summary of Scheme

The scheme is to introduce a 20mph zone together with associated traffic calming measures involving a raised table junction at Clay Lane, road hump and speed cushions, including new road markings and signs. As part of this work remedial measures are to be carried out to the highway drainage system.

Hours of work

The works will take place Monday to Fridays generally between 7.00am to 5.00pm. (Some surfacing may take place during the evening.)

Traffic management

During the course of the works, 2 & 3 way traffic lights will be erected on site to direct the flow of traffic which will cause long delays. The Alliance apologise in advance for any inconvenience that this will cause. It is our intention to avoid closing the road as part of works. However if difficulties arise, it may become essential to close the road for a very short period. Residents will be notified again if this proves necessary.

Overhanging vegetation

I would be obliged if, prior to the commencement of these works, any vegetation from your property overhanging the highway could be trimmed back to your boundary. Failure to do this may necessitate the contractor undertaking this trimming back, which may not necessarily produce the same standard that you would wish or could achieve yourself.

Parking

During the course of the works, it may be necessary to utilise some of the on-street areas which may reduce the availability of parking. This is necessary in order to permit traffic to pass the contractors plant during the works. We understand this may cause inconvenience and disruption to you, however, any suspensions will be kept to a minimum in terms of duration and length of parking places affected.
