Frequently Asked Questions:-

1. Q. **Why does this work have to take place?**
A. *Improvements to the A272 and addition of the new roundabout, were secured by HDC within the S106 Planning permissions granted for the new housing development situated in East Billingshurst.*
2. Q. **What work has to be done?**
A. *The Works involve the construction of a new roundabout which will link with the new A272 carriageway to the north and, improvements to the highway drainage within the area.*
3. Q. **What will the benefits be once it is finished?**
A. *1. Improved traffic flow around Billingshurst Village Centre.
2. New and improved drainage and street Lighting.*
4. Q. **Will any road have to be closed during the works?**
A. *Yes, the A272 will have to be closed for short periods during night surfacing works.*
5. Q. **When will the work start?**
A. *Monday 28th January 2019.*
6. Q. **When will the work finish?**
A. *Friday 2nd August 2019*
7. Q. **What type of work will the work take place?**
A. *The working hours will be (Monday - Friday 08:00-17:00)*
8. Q. **Can works be carried out at evenings or overnight?**

A. *The final surfacing works will be overnight, as stated above, but the majority of the works will be daytime working.*

9. **Q. How much will it cost and who is responsible for costs?**

A. *The final costs are unknown at this time, but all costs will be met in full by the developers.*

10. **Q. What disruption can motorists or bus passengers expect?**

A. *Traffic Lanes will be restricted by the use of 2 way lights, (manned during working hours), but closures will only apply at night.*

11. **Q. Will any diversion routes for traffic have to be put in place?**

A. *Yes, there will be a need for diversion routes whilst undertaking the night-time surfacing works. These diversions will be in place during the night-time works hours (19:00 – 06:00)*

12. **Q. Are there any other considerations people need to be aware of?**

A. *No.*
