

# A27 Worthing Vehicle Restraint System (safety barriers)

## What's happening?

A-one+ on behalf of Highways England will be carrying out the replacement of Vehicle Restraint System (safety barriers) and the relocation of road signs between Fox Patching Inn, Seldon Lane and the 40mph speed limit sign just west of Cote Street.

## Traffic management

In order to carry out these works as efficiently and as safely as possible, work will be carried out under simultaneous lane closures on the east and west bound carriageway. The works will be carried out from Tuesday 23 April 2019 to Monday 8 July 2019 and will be carried out 24/7 (Monday to Friday working) though weekends may be used as contingencies. Works are weather dependent. Bank Holiday working Monday 27 May 2019.

There will be phased overnight (8pm to 6am) closures of the east and westbound carriageways to install and remove the required traffic management.

There will be clearly signed diversions in place for the overnight closures suitable for all types of vehicles:

**Overnight Diversions Tuesday 23 April 2019 to Monday 29 April 2019:**

**Eastbound from Crossbush to Cote Street:** At Crossbush Roundabout take the A284 south to Wick Roundabout. Turn onto the A259 eastbound. At the 5<sup>th</sup> roundabout take the first left to join the A280 northbound to Long Furlong Interchange. Continue north on the A280 to Findon. At the roundabout take the 3<sup>rd</sup> turning southbound onto the A24 to re-join the A27 eastbound at Offington Roundabout.

**Westbound:** Follow the above diversion in reverse.

**Eastbound from Crossbush Roundabout to Long Furlong Interchange (A280):** At Crossbush Roundabout take the A284 south to Wick Roundabout. Turn onto the A259 eastbound. At the 5<sup>th</sup> roundabout take the first left to join the A280 northbound to Long Furlong Interchange to re-join the A27 eastbound.

**Westbound:** Follow the above diversion in reverse

**Eastbound from Long Furlong Interchange (A280 to Cote Street):** At Long Furlong Interchange take the A280 north to Findon. At the roundabout take the 3<sup>rd</sup> turning southbound onto the A24 to re-join the A27 eastbound at Offington Roundabout.

**Westbound:** Follow the above diversion in reverse.

**Overnight Diversion Tuesday 30 April 2019**

**Westbound from Long Furlong Interchange (A280) to Crossbush Roundabout:** Traffic will join the A280 Long Furlong Interchange heading west and continue until they reach the roundabout with the A259. Traffic will turn right and follow the A259 until they reach the roundabout with the A29 at Shripney roundabout, where they will turn right. Traffic will then follow the A29 until they reach the A27 at Fontwell Roundabout where they will continue on with their journey westbound.

## **Overnight Diversion Thursday 6 June and Friday 7 June**

**Westbound from Cote Street to Crossbush Roundabout:** Vehicles travelling westbound will head north at the A27/A24 Offington Roundabout. Traffic will continue along the A24 until they reach the roundabout with the A280 where they will turn left. Traffic will then follow the A280 south until they reach Long Furlong Interchange. Traffic will then join the A280 heading west and continue until they reach the roundabout with the A259. Traffic will turn right and follow the A259 until they reach the roundabout with the A29 at Shripney roundabout, where they will turn right. Traffic will then follow the A29 until they reach the A27 at Fontwell Roundabout where they will continue with their journey.

## **Overnight Diversion Saturday 8 June and Sunday 9 June**

**Eastbound from Crossbush Roundabout to Cote Street:** Follow the above diversion in reverse

**Escorted access will be provided to all residents during the full closures with access only from the A27.**

**Emergency vehicles will be given access at all times.**
