

# Carriageway Micro Surfacing

This process will involve overlaying the surface layer with a new bituminous surface. Micro-asphalt surface is a thin layer of asphalt which seals the road surface against water damage and restores skid-resistance. This treatment is suitable for use on residential roads.

The new surface will also look extremely black and may appear messy when first laid. This is normal and due to the material used. The surface will gradually look like an ordinary road as it stabilises which usually takes three to four weeks.

Road closures may be in force in order to safeguard both our workforce and members of the public.

Before the work starts 'advance warning' signs will be erected stating the start date, duration and whether a road closure will be used.

Please ensure you do not park your car on the street on the day of works unless you have off-street parking.

Access to your property will be available throughout the works but there may be a delay while material is being laid. If you have any questions or concerns about access during the work, please ask for the site foreman who will be happy to help you.

We will endeavour to keep disruption to a minimum and if at any time you require assistance, please ask our expert site personnel.

Please note that the surface of the new carriageway can be slightly sticky and a residue may remain for a short period of time. We would advise taking necessary precautions to avoid this being walked into your property.
