

# Cheals Roundabout

## What has happened so far?

So far we have completed the following:

- Diverted all the required utilities including power, gas & telecoms
- Formed a new footpath on the Horsham Road going westbound including new cycle access & lighting columns
- Formed part of the new footpath on the Horsham Road going eastbound (by the Squires Garden Centre)
- Formed the bases for the new lanes on the roundabout approach & exit from Horsham
- Installed new drainage to improve road conditions

## What's happening next?

The next 3 phases will be happening over the next 2 months. From the end of March 2019 traffic going towards Horsham will be running on the new lane 1. Please take care on this lane as it is a temporary road surface until the full resurfacing works happen.

Full details of what is happening next are:

### Phase 3: March 2019 – April 2019

- Close lane 2 of Horsham Road approach & exit to Cheals Roundabout
- Close lane 2 of Crawley Avenue approach & exit to Cheals Roundabout
- Install new highway drainage
- Break out old Horsham road central reservation and install a new central reservation
- Construct an additional approach lane to the roundabout from Horsham
- Widen Crawley Avenue lane 2 & install pedestrian crossings

### Phase 4 & 5: April 2019 – May 2019

- Close lane 1 of Horsham Road approach & exit to Cheals Roundabout
- Close lane 1 of Crawley Avenue approach & exit to Cheals Roundabout
- Construct Horsham Road to Crawley Avenue separator island
- Landscaping including new footpaths & pedestrian crossings
- Night time closure of the roundabout for full resurfacing & white lining
