

A264 Tollgate Hill Roundabout, Crawley Frequently Asked Questions

1. Why do the works have to take place?

The works are taking place to enable a dedicated vehicle and pedestrian entrance to the new Crawley Borough Council Cemetery (http://www.crawley.gov.uk/pw/Council_Services_and_Democracy/Council_Services/Births_Marriages_and_Deaths/Cemeteries/index.htm).

2. What work has to be done?

The existing A264 carriageway requires kerb and road re-alignment, to allow the access to be created to the Cemetery. A dedicated toucan crossing will be installed on the eastside of the Tollgate Hill Roundabout to allow pedestrians to cross safely to the Cemetery from the bus stop located on Tollgate Hill. The works also include the installation of new Armco barrier, street lighting and signage and cycle path.

3. What will the benefits be once it is finished?

The benefits will include safer access to the new Cemetery via vehicle, by foot or by bicycle.

4. Will any roads have to be closed during the works?

No roads will be closed. Lane closures will be required along the A264 to enable the works to be carried out. Work will be during off peak times only.

5. When will the works start and finish?

The works are planned to start on Monday 13th February 2017 and will last approx. 6 weeks.

6. What time will the work take place?

Work will take place during off peak times (09:30–15:30).

7. What disruption can motorists or bus passengers expect?

Only minor disruption is expected as the works are being carried out during off peak times (09:30–15:30). However, motorists travelling during these hours are advised to allow extra time for their journey. West Sussex County Council will be monitoring the traffic flows whilst the works are being carried out.

8. Will any diversion routes for traffic have to be put in place?

No. As the A264 is a dual carriageway, only require one lane at a time to be closed to carry out the works.
