

Warnham - Byfleets Lane improvements

Frequently Asked Questions

- 1. Why does this work have to take place?**
Byfleets Lane is a narrow road with no existing passing places causing possible conflict between oncoming vehicles resulting in damaged verges. The work here is to provide passing places along Byfleets Lane to reduce potential conflict and protect the verges in Byfleets Lane.
- 2. What work has to be done?**
The works will consist of the installation of passing spaces at regular intervals along Byfleets Lane. Geotextile verge protection will also be installed.
- 3. Will any road have to be closed during the works?**
Byfleets Lane will have to be closed during the works. This will be phased to ensure access to dwellings and businesses in Byfleets Lane remains.
- 4. When will the work start?**
The work will start on Monday 27th February 2017.
- 5. When will the work finish?**
The works will take up to 12 weeks and should be completed by Monday 8th May 2017.
- 6. What time of day will the work take place?**
The work will take place Monday to Friday during daylight working hours. However, due to the site constraints, please be advised that the road closure will be active 24hours a day for the duration of the works. This will not prevent access.
- 7. Will works be carried out at evenings or overnight?**
There may be some evening working to minimise disruption to both the public and businesses but this will be kept to a minimum.
- 8. How much will it cost and what are the benefits?**
The cost of the scheme is circa. £150k. It will provide an improved route for vehicles and provide protection to the verges.
- 9. Why have you chosen to do this at this time of year?**
The work start date has been dictated by availability of road space, plant, material and personnel. We will ensure that disruption to the public and businesses is kept to a minimum and will endeavour to have works finished within the 12 week duration allocated, subject to suitable weather conditions.
