

## **Warnham - Strood Lane improvements**

### **Frequently Asked Questions**

**1. Why does this work have to take place?**

The improvements works at Strood Lane are being implemented following community concern over the usage of the county lanes in the Parish of Warnham. Works will be undertaken to prohibit left turn manoeuvres into Strood Lane from the A281 and right turn manoeuvres from Strood Lane onto the A281 to alleviate these concerns.

**2. What work has to be done?**

To prohibit left turn manoeuvres into Strood Lane from the A281 and right turn manoeuvres from Strood Lane onto the A281 the junction alignment will change and a build out introduced to discourage these manoeuvres. The prohibition will apply to motor vehicles only with accommodation to allow cyclists through the build out.

**3. Will any road have to be closed during the works?**

Strood Lane will have to be closed during the works at its junction with the A281. A diversion route will be in place during the works.

**4. When will the work start?**

The work will start on Monday 13<sup>th</sup> February 2017.

**5. When will the work finish?**

The works will take up to 4 weeks and should be completed by Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> March 2017.

**6. What time of day will the work take place?**

The work will take place Monday to Friday during daylight working hours. However, due to the site constraints, please be advised that the road closure will be active 24hours a day for the duration of the works and a diversion route in place.

**7. Will works be carried out at evenings or overnight?**

There may be some evening working to minimise disruption to both the public and businesses but this will be kept to a minimum.

**8. How much will it cost and what are the benefits?**

The cost of the scheme is circa. £50k. It will address community concerns over usage of the Warnham lanes and encourage drivers to travel on more appropriate routes in this vicinity.

**9. Why have you chosen to do this at this time of year?**

The work start date has been dictated by availability of road space, plant, material and personnel. We will ensure that disruption to the public and businesses is kept to a minimum and will endeavour to have works finished within the 4 week duration allocated, subject to suitable weather conditions.
