Project: Pedestrian Crossing Refurbishment

I am pleased to inform you that as part of our continuing efforts to improve the highways, work is due to commence soon at Brighton Road near Shopsdam Road, Lancing.

What we're doing

This project will include;

- Upgrading obsolete traffic signals equipment with new poles, traffic signals controller and more energy efficient LED traffic signal heads.
- Inclusion of pedestrian beepers and rotating, cone-shaped tactile devices under the push button panel to aid visually-impaired pedestrians whilst using the crossing.
- Introducing new 'pedestrian on crossing' detectors to minimise delays for traffic while ensuring there is enough time for pedestrians to cross safely.
- Replacing the corroded traffic signal poles.
- Pedestrian tactile paving is to be replaced.

When this will take place

The work will start on 26th November 2018 *and* is expected to take approximately two and a half weeks to complete. Our hours of work will generally be between 8:00am and 6:00pm.

Due to the nature of the works being delivered you may experience some disturbance and we apologise for this in advance.

Before the works start, we will erect advance warning signs in the local area, letting you know any changes to the start date.

Road Restrictions during the work

In order to protect our workforce and the public, 24hr 2-way traffic management will be required and will remain onsite for the duration of the work.

In addition, a temporary pedestrian crossing will be onsite for the duration of the work.
