Enhancements and Improvement Works

West Sussex County Council needs to carry out works close to your property soon and we are contacting you today to let you know what we are doing.



What we're doing

Enhancement and improvement works will soon start along **Broomers Hill Lane/Cray Lane, Pulborough.**

The scheme is to improve road safety by resurfacing the carriageway; installing road markings and high friction surfacing on the approach to the level crossing on Cray Lane.

How will this affect you?

Work is expected to take place on **Friday 14th June 2019**, between the hours of **08:00am** and **18:00pm**.

Temporary traffic management in the form of a **road closure** will be in operation to protect the public and our workforce. Residents will be unable to park on the road when our surfacing operations are being carried out. Access will always be provided to residents within closed areas, although there may be some delay to ensure the site is safe to pass through.

Please plan your journey in advance, and look out for important safety signs along your route. If you have any concerns regarding access during these works please ask the onsite staff, your safety is our priority.
