## Safety Barrier Upgrades



### What we're doing

Safety barrier upgrade works will soon start along **Goring Overbridge, Worthing**. Works are expected to take place from **Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> July 2019** to **Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> August 2019** between **07:00am** and **16:30pm**.

The works will soon consist of replacing the old barriers with new ones.

### How will this affect you?

Traffic management will be in operation; this will consist of a **multi-way lights**. Access will be provided to residents within closed areas, although there may be a slight delay in getting through. Pedestrian access should not be affected providing there are footpaths to use; if not the onsite team will assist with the safety of pedestrian access.

Please note that these works are subject to changes due to weather conditions, equipment breakdown or emergency work taking priority.
