What we're doing

Carriageway patching works will soon start along **High Street junction with High Beeches Lane, Slaugham**. The works will involve repairing the road surface with new materials, as the road surface has deteriorated significantly.

How will this affect you?

Work is expected to take place from **Monday 13th May 2019** to **Wednesday 15th May 2019** between **19:00pm** to **06:00am**.

Temporary traffic management in the form of a night **road closure** and **2 way lights** will be in operation to protect the public and our workforce. **Residents will be unable to park on the road when our surfacing operations are being carried out**. Access to properties and premises within the closed area will be maintained where possible. There may be periods when access will not be immediately possible to prevent damage to vehicles or unreasonable interruption to the works being carried out. Pedestrian access will be maintained and managed at all times.

Please note that these works are subject to changes due to weather conditions, equipment breakdown or emergency work taking priority.
