**Project: Refurbishment of a Signalised Junction**

I am pleased to inform you that as part of our continuing efforts to improve the highways, work is due to commence soon at the signalised junction of High Street & Malthouse Lane, Selsey.

**What we're doing**

This project will include;

- Upgrading obsolete traffic signals equipment with new poles, traffic signals controller and more energy efficient LED traffic signal heads.
- Upgrading of the Far-Sided crossings to the latest, Near-Sided style.
- The inclusion of additional detectors that will allow for priority to be returned to vehicles once the pedestrians are safely crossed, meaning less time wasted for drivers.
- Replacement of the existing tactile paving.
- Updating to a more reactive method of control.
- Addition of an extra controlled pedestrian crossing outside Lloyds Pharmacy.
- Following the previously undertaken public consultation, held between 7<sup>th</sup> & 21<sup>st</sup> February 2019, as part of these works the stand alone pedestrian crossing will be being removed.

**When this is anticipated to take place**

The work will start Monday 9<sup>th</sup> September 2019 and is expected to take upto 16 weeks to complete. Our hours of work will *generally* be between 08:30 and 16:30.

Before the works start, we will erect advance warning signs in the local area, letting you know any changes to the start date and marking the extent of the works.
