West Sussex County Council needs to carry out works close to your property soon and we are contacting you today to let you know what we are doing.



What we're doing

Enhancement and improvement works will soon start along **Ifield Avenue, Crawley**.

The scheme will comprise of installing a cycleway to improve safety for cyclists and motorists.

How will this affect you?

Work is expected to take place from **16th September 2019** to **20th December 2019**, between the hours of **07:30am** and **18:00pm**.

Temporary traffic management in the form of a **two-way signals** will be in operation to protect the public and our workforce. Access will always be provided to residents within work areas, although there may be some delay to ensure the site is safe to pass through.

Please plan your journey in advance, and look out for important safety signs along your route. If you have any concerns regarding access during these works please ask the onsite staff, your safety is our priority.

While work is being carried out at the junctions of Stagelands, Stafford Rd & Rushetts Rd, temporary closures of the side roads will be necessary. **Please be aware that yellow advance warning boards will be situated on these roads to warn residents and businesses of closure two weeks prior.** There will be signed diversions for vehicle traffic.
