Dear Resident / Business owner,

### **Shripney Road, Bognor Regis**

West Sussex County Council needs to carry out road works close to your property soon and we are contacting you today to let you know what we are doing.

#### **What work has to be done?**

Carriageway resurfacing of Shripney Road northbound between Orchard Way roundabout and Rowan Way roundabout. The existing surfacing will be removed, and a new road surface will be laid in its place.

#### **When will the works take place?**

The reconstruction of the carriageway will take place on **Sunday 22 September and between Sunday 29 September – Wednesday 2 October 2019**. Work to establish the diversion route will take place in advance of the main construction works, however the diversion will only be in operation while our works are being carried out.

#### **What time of day will the work take place?**

The main resurfacing/reconstruction works will take place overnight, between 8pm and 6am each day. Sunday works will begin at 6pm.

#### **Why does this work have to take place?**

The current road is showing signs of significant weakening of the carriageway structure and needs to be repaired in order to provide a safe and durable surface on which to travel.

#### **What disruption can be expected?**

Access and egress will be restricted while our works are being undertaken. We will do our best to maintain access, but delays may occur for operational and/or safety reasons.

Residents of Poplars Court Caravan Park will have access and egress maintained although there may be a delay until a suitable time in the resurfacing works. Our works will generate noise and dust, but we will do all we can to keep this to a minimum.

Sections of Shripney Road northbound will be **closed** in phases to all vehicles while our surfacing operations are being carried out. Vehicles, including buses, will be diverted via a signed diversion route. Access to all properties will be maintained whenever possible. However, when works are being carried out in the immediate vicinity delays may occur for operational and/or safety reasons. If immediate access might be required when our works are being carried out in these locations, it may be advisable to make alternative parking arrangements outside of the working area.

### I am expecting a delivery during the works. What will happen?

Access for deliveries to retail businesses will be maintained at all times and our traffic management and resurfacing teams will do their best to ensure that any disruption is kept to a minimum. However, delays may occur for operational and safety reasons.

If possible, all deliveries should be arranged to take place either before or after the works. If this is not possible, then please contact West Sussex Highways via [www.westsussex.gov.uk/roadpavementenquiry](http://www.westsussex.gov.uk/roadpavementenquiry)

### Could weather impact the proposed works?

Weather conditions can have an impact on the delivery of the scheme. In the event that the works are delayed we may choose to mitigate the delay by working over weekends.

### Who will be carrying out the works?

Our contractor is Balfour Beatty Living Places. There may however be workers and works vehicles from other contractors working on this project.
