What we're doing

Tree Works will soon start outside **6 & 7 Stanford Avenue, Hassocks**. The works are for an estimated 30% crown reduction, along with crown lifting works on all aspects. Dead wood and selected branches will be removed. In line with our works practice, trees will be checked for any nests beforehand, and if any are found, the works to that particular tree will not commence, instead it will be left until the birds have flown.

How will this affect you?

Work is expected to take place on the **Tuesday 12th February 2019** and **Wednesday 13th February 2019**, between the hours of **09:30am to 16:30pm**.

Please note that this is subject to changes due to weather conditions, equipment breakdown or emergency work taking priority.

Traffic management will be in operation, as this work will consist of a **road closure**. Access will be provided to residents within closed areas, although there may be a slight delay in getting through. Please plan your journey in advance and follow the clearly marked diversion route via **Station Approach West, Keymer Road, London Road, and Stanford Avenue**.

If you have any concerns regarding access during these works please ask the onsite staff, your safety is our priority.
