West Sussex County Council needs to carry out highway-related works close to your property soon and we are contacting you today to let you know what we are doing.

Footway Microasphalt Surface Treatment



What we're doing

Footway microsurfacing works will soon start on **Station Road, Petworth**. The work will involve applying a new surface material to the existing footway, which will fill in cracks and holes, smooth out dips and bumps and seal the surface to prevent water damage.

How will this affect you?

Work is expected to take place on **16th September 2019** and **20th September 2019**, and the working hours will be from **07:30am to 17:00pm**.

Traffic management will be in operation; this will consist of **multiway lights**. Residents will be unable to park on the road when our surfacing operations are being carried out. Access will be provided to residents within closed areas, although there may be a slight delay in getting through. Pedestrian access should not be affected providing there are footpaths to use; if not the onsite team will assist with the safety of pedestrian access.

Please note that these works are subject to changes due to weather conditions, equipment breakdown or emergency work taking priority.
