Micro-asphalt Carriageway Surface Treatment



What we're doing

Micro-asphalt carriageway surfacing will soon start along **Kennedy Avenue, East Grinstead**. The works will involve laying two layers of fine graded stone in a bitumen emulsion. A regulating layer is laid first to cover any undulations and to help seal the surface followed by a second layer which will be the running surface. This is a preventative treatment to protect the road from further damage as the road surface has deteriorated significantly over recent years.

Please follow the clearly marked diversion route, (yellow signs with black direction arrows).

How will this affect you?

Work is expected to take place on **9th September 2019** between **08:00am** to **18:00pm**.

Traffic management will be in operation; this will consist of a **road closure**. Residents will be unable to park on the road when our surfacing operations are being carried out. A Traffic Regulation Order will be in place, prohibiting the use of the road by vehicles. Any vehicle parked on the road during this time may be subject to a Fixed Penalty Notice.

Access will be provided to residents within closed areas, although there may be a slight delay of up to half an hour in getting through. If immediate access might be required when our works are being carried out it may be advisable to make alternative parking arrangements outside of the working area.

Pedestrian access should not be affected providing there are footpaths to use; if not the onsite team will assist with the safety of pedestrian access. Please take great care when crossing the road on the new surface to avoid stepping in wet material.

Please note that these works are subject to changes due to weather conditions, equipment breakdown or emergency work taking priority.
